



Advanced Patient Imaging Scheduling

How do I refer a patient to Advanced Patient Imaging?

- Simply fill out a referral form and give it to your patient. If you would like a pad of referral forms, we can drop a pad by your office or mail them directly to you. The referral form can also be found on our website.

How do I schedule a patient?

- Our scheduling phone number is (513) 753-7444. You can schedule from your office or have your patient call to set up an appointment.

When will I receive a report?

- MRI
 - Once the exam is completed, the referring doctor will receive a copy of the report within 24 hours.

How will I receive the report?

- Either by fax or email. Please indicate at the bottom of the referral form the method of delivery.

Are there any special patient preparations for an exam?

- MRI
 - For any MRI with contrast, lab work to verify creatinine levels is needed on the following patient types: over age 70, diabetic, decreased kidney function, only one kidney present or known kidney disease.
- Ultrasound
 - Abdominal Aorta and Renal Artery ultrasounds require fasting 8 hours prior to study.

What is the cost for an exam?

- MRI
 - The cost for a single MRI exam of any kind is \$495.00. This price is all inclusive with no additional fees.
- Ultrasound
 - The cost for a single ultrasound exam of any kind is \$250.00 with the exception of an echocardiogram which costs \$350.00. These prices are all inclusive with no additional fees.

Do you participate with insurance providers?

- Other than Anthem BCBS, we do not participate with any insurance company or federal or state healthcare programs. The patient is responsible for payment, which is due at the time of service. We accept major credit cards (Visa, MasterCard, Amex and Discover) or debit cards as the method of payment.
