## ADVANCED PATIENT IMAGING

### **HOW DO I PREPARE FOR AN ULTRASOUND EXAM?**

- Abdominal Aorta and Renal Artery ultrasounds require fasting 8 hours prior to exam. Make sure the meal you eat 8 hours prior to your exam is a light meal that consist of non-gassy foods.
- If you take medication, take it as prescribed.
- For all other ultrasounds, there are no specific preparations needed. You may go about your normal activities.
- Please plan on arriving at least 15 minutes prior to your scheduled time to register and complete paperwork.
- Once you have arrived and checked in, you will be met by one of our trained Ultrasound Technologists who will review your paperwork, carefully screen you for conditions that may be problematic and answer any questions you might have about your exam.
- Wear a comfortable, loose-fitting, two-piece outfit.
- You may be required to change into a gown for the procedure.
