

### What Is Vascular Disease?

Vascular disease is a general term for a group of problems that affect your blood vessels, such as those that carry oxygen-rich blood through the body.

People who have vascular disease may have health problems including aneurysm, peripheral artery disease (PAD) and risk of stroke.

### Risk Factors for Vascular Disease

You should consider a vascular screening if you have any of the following risk factors:

- Age (50 years or older)
- Smoking
- High blood pressure
- Diabetes
- Obesity
- High cholesterol
- Family history for vascular disease
- Prior heart attack or bypass operation




ABDOMINAL AORTIC ANEURYSMS (AAA)

### Why Have Vascular Screening?

Early detection and proactive management of cardiovascular disease is a key part of maintaining a healthy lifestyle. We offer three types of vascular screenings to help detect vascular disease.

The screenings include:

- Abdominal Aortic Aneurysms (AAA)
- Carotid Artery Disease
- Peripheral Artery Disease (PAD)

### How Is The Screening Performed?

The exam consists of three screenings together lasting approximately 30 minutes, which are painless. We use ultrasound technology to perform the exams.

The three non-invasive tests include:

- Ultrasound of the carotid arteries in the neck
- Ultrasound of the abdominal aorta
- Ankle brachial index (blood pressure cuffs on the arms and legs)

All exams are performed by registered vascular technologists. A board certified vascular surgeon will review your results. A preliminary report will be provided the day of your screening with a full report within 48 hours.

**AVOID FOOD AT LEAST 2 HOURS PRIOR TO SCREENING.**

## Signs & Symptoms of Vascular Disease

### Abdominal Aortic Aneurysm (AAA)

- Usually has no symptoms

### Peripheral Artery Disease (PAD)

- Painful cramping in hips, thighs or calves when walking, climbing stairs or exercising, usually pain stops when activity stops
- Discoloration of foot
- Marked decrease in temperature of lower leg or foot especially compared to other foot or leg

### Stroke

- Numbness, weakness of face, arm or leg – often only on one side of the body
- Sudden confusion or trouble speaking
- Trouble seeing in one or both eyes
- Sudden difficulty walking, dizziness, loss of balance or coordination

### How Do I Pay?

We accept all major credit cards and debit cards. Payment is due at the time of the service. All three screenings (Carotid Artery Disease screening, Peripheral Artery Disease screening and Abdominal Aortic Aneurysms (AAA) screening) are included for only \$100.

**Screenings are not covered by insurance or Medicare.**
